## Insurance / Health Report by Joe Polce

#### **Deductibles for 2018**

The Medicare Part B deductible is \$183.00. This amount must be paid before United Health Care will pay a claim. The dental allowance of \$1000/2000 was reset on January 1, 2018.

#### **Medicare Part B Premiums for 2018**

The new monthly premiums for Medicare Part B range from \$134.00 to \$428.60 depending on the member's yearly income. The exact information can be viewed at the <u>mymedicare.gov</u> web site. The 2% increase in benefits did not go very far with the increase in Part B premiums.

#### Tax Form 1095C

This form is being mailed to all retirees from FCPS. It just proves that health coverage was provided in 2017 in accordance with the ACA guidelines.

#### **Medical Vendor Contract**

The contract with United Health Care will expire on June 30, 2018. The rebid process has begun. The consultant firm Trion is helping with this process. It should be very interesting.

#### **CVS Minute Clinics**

There are two such clinics in Frederick at 8032 Liberty Road and 300 Ballenger Creek Drive. There are also Minute Clinics in New Market (5414 Rotary Ave.) and Urbana (3350 Worthington Road). I have used the one at Liberty Road and was very satisfied. Registration can be done online. The registration process is a bit cumbersome, but aren't they all? The Minute Clinics are another option to the Emergency Room or Immediate Care and provide the same basic services. Go to <a href="cvs.com">cvs.com</a> and click on MinuteClinic for more information.
