

Cash paying members should soon receive their dues notice if it has not already arrived. Local-only members' bills were mailed the last week of May.

If you have your dues deducted from your pension check, dues will be deducted from your July 31 check.



MRSPA has extended an invitation to cash members to switch to dues deduction for 2021-2022. If you make the change, you are eligible for a one-time \$10 reduction in state dues.
